

Admissions Timeline for review and consultation 2018/19 For the year 20/21, admission in September 2020

September 2018 onwards If changes are planned, the arrangements should be reviewed at the earliest opportunity in the new school year in order to allow for consultation with the Diocese. The diocese is offering consultation dropins for any admission arrangement queries and reviews in September 2018.	Review and propose	The Governing body, as Admission Authority, reviews admission arrangements with regard to the School Admissions Code December 2014 and with reference to the LA co-ordinated admission scheme
October 1 2018	Start of formal consultation period	This is the earliest date to begin formal consultation if changes are proposed, or at least every 7 years.
By 10 November 2018	Consultation with the Diocesan Board of Education where changes are proposed or at least every 7 years	Governing body sends admission arrangements, including any SIF, to the Diocesan Board of Education
By 30 November The Diocese will respond to all arrangements needing consultation by 30 November to allow the admission authority to make recommended changes before going out to full consultation	Advice from the Diocese Review by the governing body	Governing body should follow advice given by the Diocesan Board of Education (this is specifically in relation to faith criteria, although guidance will be given on compliance to all schools in our SLA) and prepare firm proposal arrangements
