

Admissions Timeline for review and consultation 2020/21 For the year 22/22, admission in September 2022

<u>Please note: If you haven't consulted on your admission arrangements within the last 7 years, you must do so this year even if you are not proposing any changes.</u>

Date	Activity	Detail
September 2020 onwards If changes are planned, the arrangements should be reviewed at the earliest opportunity in the new school year in order to allow for consultation with the Diocese. The diocese is offering consultation drop-ins for any admission arrangement queries and reviews in October 2020.	Review and propose	The Governing body, as Admission Authority, reviews admission arrangements with regard to the School Admissions Code December 2014 and with reference to the LA co-ordinated admission scheme
October 1 2020	Start of formal consultation period	This is the earliest date to begin formal consultation if changes are proposed, or at least every 7 years.
By end of November 2020	Consultation with the Diocesan Board of Education where changes are proposed or at least every 7 years	Governing body sends admission arrangements, including any SIF, to the Diocesan Board of Education
The Diocese will respond to all arrangements needing consultation by 4 th December to allow the admission authority to make recommended changes before going out to full consultation	Advice from the Diocese Review by the governing body	Governing body should follow advice given by the Diocesan Board of Education (this is specifically in relation to faith criteria, although guidance will be given on compliance to all schools in our SLA) and prepare firm proposal arrangements
1 October 18 to 31 January 2021	Statutory Consultation period,	Statutory consultation with other admission authorities interested parties a minimum of 6 weeks between 1 October and 31 January
31 January – 28 February 2021	Determination and Notification	All admission authorities must determine admission arrangements by 28 February every year even if they have not changed from previous years and a consultation has not been required. Admission authorities must notify the appropriate bodies and must publish a copy of the determined arrangements on their website displaying them for a whole year.
