

## BUTTERFLY INSTALLATION : DIOCESAN YEAR 6 LEAVERS CELEBRATION

Our theme this year for our Leavers Celebration is **“Called by Name”** based on *“I have called you by name; you are mine”* Isaiah 43:1.

While we cannot bring Year 6 pupils together in person, we would like to create an art installation at Chichester Cathedral including individual works of art from Year 6 pupils from across the diocese to show that they are part of a larger family of schools.

We would like to invite each of your Year 6 children to make a **two-sided colourful** butterfly with their **first name only** on it which will be installed in the Cathedral to make up an art installation. These butterflies symbolise both their transition from primary to secondary school, and hope for the future as we emerge from the pandemic.

The butterflies should be:

- **no larger than 6” x 6”** as they will have to be posted to or dropped off at the Cathedral
- **Bright colours on both sides** of the paper – preferably not coloured pencils or crayon as they will need to stand out amongst many (see example images below)
- Be **firm** enough to either hang from a string or attached to a wire from above or below
- They can take any form i.e. cut out and painted, origami (two-sided colour paper), mosaic, stained glass effect etc.
- First name only of each child on their butterfly
- They should be with the Cathedral (address below) by Friday 28 May - this gives us time to make them into an installation

We hope you and the children enjoy creating your butterflies and see them as their hope, transformation and flight into their future lives as they move from primary to secondary school.
