This booklet considers how faith can be sustained in school leaders and how it can, in turn, provide a sustaining foundation for their leadership actions. How can school leaders sustain themselves and their schools in hope, maintaining the vision of a better future within the constantly changing education landscape?


Drawing on interviews with school leaders, and offering personal reflection opportunities, this booklet explores how leaders can secure hope, implement vision and sustain resilience.

Foundation Governors agree to attend safeguarding training in the first year of their appointment. Due to the requirement under Keeping Children Safe in Education 2022 this should be done much earlier. Our course is designed to put safeguarding into the context of the Church of England. All other governors should now attend some safeguarding training anyway and this course is suitable. The next date is 4pm on 12 January.
