Twineham School stands next to the village church at the end of a Sussex country lane. Although a rural school, we are well connected being situated close to the A23 between Brighton and Crawley.

We have four classrooms, together with a library area, hall, shared working areas and offices. Outside are a full sized sports playground, a smaller playground and a large field with a trim-trail, tyre garden, a small pond and garden.

Pupils also have the opportunity to work with larger groups of children of their own age through the Network of Eastern Area Rural Schools (NEARS), with ten member schools who hold regular shared events such as sports fixtures.
