#### **Welcome to our Training Brochure**

The Diocese of Chichester is home to 154 schools across three Local Authorities and a selection of Multi Academy Trusts. We are uniquely placed to walk alongside school leaders, supporting them in their work which enables their schools and communities to flourish. Working with such a large group of schools our work is founded on the Diocese of Chichester' Christian principles and expectations of the Diocesan Board of Education Measure.

Each year our training programme provides opportunities to join with others across the Diocese to learn together on a range of continuing professional development offers. There is typically a wealth of networks, workshops, courses and briefings which are both remote and face to face.

The majority of courses are available to schools that have signed up to the Diocesan Partnership Agreement at no extra charge. There is a minimal charge for larger events such as the Headteachers Conference; any courses with a different pricing structure are marked\*

All courses are booked via <u>TryBooking</u>.

### Wellbeing

Wellbeing and pastoral support are key priorities for the Diocesan Education Team's work with schools, and particularly with school leaders, as they respond to the diverse challenges of their roles.

The School Effectiveness Officers (SEO) provide pastoral support and listening ears for school staff and all previous or serving headteachers. The SEO team understand the pressures of school leadership and are able to empathise and support. Simply contact the school's named SEO by phone or email and they will respond as soon as possible.
